The External Quality Assurance Cell has conducted Green Audit of Hindu College, Delhi for Academic Year 2021-22

The purpose of the audit was to ensure that the practices followed in the campus are in accordance with the Academic policies adopted by the institution. With this in mind, the specific objectives of the audit were to evaluate the adequacy of the management control framework the Departments to ensure that they are in compliance with the applicable regulations, policies and standards.



During the initial planning of the audit, an analysis was conducted in order to identify, evaluate and prioritize the quality parameters in line with the global accreditation standards. The analysis was based upon an examination of the policies, manuals and standards that govern the green/environment quality and sustainability, on data analysis, and on the results of preliminary interviews with personnel considered key in the environmental management in the campus. The criteria and methods used in the audit were based on the identified risks.

The methodology used included physical inspection, review of the relevant documentation, and interviews. Reliance was placed on the third-party data provided by the institution.
