
Following were the points of discussion:

- All the members were informed about the Asian Undergraduate Summit which would be held in the month of March, 2018. The theme of AUS was proposed as "Leadership in a Complex World: Taking On Diffused Responsibilities" which would be held in two parts:- (i) Hindu College and (ii) National University of Singapore (NUS) where students of Hindu College as well as National University of Singapore (NUS) would be participate and engage in discussions on issues pertinent to India: Impact of Demonetization and Skill Education. A few group activities were planned wherein students from different countries would be creating a distinct cultural setting, to find

solutions to real- world problems through "Design Thinking Methodology" and finally present it to the panel of experts.

- A few other upcoming activities having strong social cause were also mentioned which would be held in the upcoming months by various societies of the college:-
  - (i) Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat: Hon'ble Prime Minister of India for promoting national integration through mutual appreciation of the diverse culture of the Country.

  - (v) SVEEP campaign -Informing and educating
  - (vi) Vigilance Awareness Seminar- Eradicate Corruption-Build a New India
  - (vii) Vaktavya -Summit
  - (viii) Knowledge Panchayat
  - (ix) Hindu Earth Summit 2018 is "Eco-Warriors- Redemption of an Ailing Planet"Principal appreciated the ideas and efforts that were being directed by the faculty advisors and the students constantly.
- Discussions were also held on revision of syllabus in close association with their respective university level departments particularly in the context of the Choice Based Credit System.
- Discussions were also carried out on acquiring regular feedback from students through suitably designed feedback forms.
- Principal made a special mention of the notable achievement about Hindu College entering into a new phase in its history by becoming a residential College for Girls as well. She further mentioned that the Girls hostel has become fully functional with nearly 150 students enjoying modern comforts and amenities in verdant surroundings of the College campus. The Wi-Fi enabled hostel has air-conditioned rooms, common rooms, well-equipped pantries, laundry rooms with automatic washing machines on each floor, badminton court and medical room.
- Members were also notified about the new four storeyed Academic block with 50000.sq ft covered area which was ready to be inaugurated. It has lecture rooms, conference rooms and laboratories to meet the demands of the growing strength of the College.
- Members were also informed that by July 2018, direct recruitment of 26 non-teaching staff would be done.

Dr. Shalini Suryanarayan, Director IQAC, announced the launch of the following programmes/courses/upcoming workshops:-

- **Launch of Certificate/Diploma Course**

Launch of a new course entitled "Behavioral Economics" was announced which would be starting from 20<sup>th</sup> January, 2020.

- **Mentorship Programme**

Members were informed about the introduction of a Mentor-Mentee Programme by Hindu College, individualized and flexible to meet the students' growth in all areas of life. In this program 10 to 15 (mentees) are assigned to a mentor (faculty) of the college for effective mentoring. Mentors are matched with their mentees and the college ensures to avoid conflicts of interest within their progress of the study. Mentees can express their views, share their thoughts and problems with the mentors. Mentors act as foster-parents and guide in any area of life to the mentees by providing guidance, counselling, and advice in any area of life, especially in academics as per the need expressed by the mentees.

- **Interdisciplinary Research Projects**

To promote the research environment in the college, chair announced the launch of a scheme of Interdisciplinary Research Projects which would give the undergraduate students an exposure of research that is happening across the globe. Through these projects, the students and the teachers together will be able to move beyond the boundaries of their own subject and help in solving the real world challenges. Each project has 2-3 teachers and 10 students from different discipline. A grant of Rs 2.5 lakhs was sanctioned for the projects involving experimental sciences. The Projects involving Theoretical Sciences, Humanities Social Sciences were sanctioned a grant of Rs 1.5 Lakhs each.

- **Workshops/Seminars**

All the members were apprised about the upcoming workshops which included:

- Recent Trends in Chemical Sciences (RTCS-2019) by Department of Chemistry, Hindu College in collaboration with Green Chemistry Network Centre, Delhi University and Royal Society of Chemistry, London North India Section being held on 30<sup>th</sup> August, 2018 at Hotel Maiden's, Civil Lines, India.
- RSC Workshop on "Periodic Table: a boon for mankind Department of Chemistry, Hindu College in collaboration with Green Chemistry Network Centre, Delhi University and Royal Society of Chemistry, London North India Section being held on 1<sup>st</sup> September, 2018 at Hotel Maiden's, Civil Lines, India.
- Interdisciplinary Workshop on Indigenous Instrumentation and Computational Packages for Cutting Edge Research by Department of Physics, Chemistry, Botany and Zoology on to be held on 18<sup>th</sup> September, 2019.
- Indo-UK workshop Green Chemistry for Societal Needs: Healthcare, Pollution and Circular Economies being held on 16<sup>th</sup> December, 2019. Members were informed that a total of 50 participants would be selected globally for this workshop, 25 from India and 25 from UK while maintaining gender balance. This workshop would provide opportunities for networking and joint collaborative projects.

- ACS Workshop on Greening our Education System: Initiatives for Propagating and Preaching Beyond Benign Concepts in Classrooms and Laboratories being held by Department of Chemistry, Hindu College on 2<sup>nd</sup> March, 2020 in which Dr. Mary Kirchoff, Director, Green Chemistry Institute, American Chemical Society would be there as a valuable resource person.

- **Green Infrastructure of Sewage Treatment Plant:**

Members were apprised that Hindu college has been the first in the University to have constructed a Sewage Treatment Plant of 500,000 L/D capacity which is now fully functional.

Following strategies were highlighted:-


1. Switch to Learning Management System (LMS) through Microsoft Teams for the entire college along with Microsoft Office complete package, to facilitate the online classes where separate classes would be created and students would be added.
2. Use of writing pads would be encouraged specially the science streams for the effective teaching.
3. Setup of audio-visual labs and teachers use this facility to deliver online lectures that utilize multimedia to explain complex concepts which require visualization.
4. Other kinds of creative online evaluative strategies, like oral tests, quizzes, objective tests, presentations would be encouraged.
5. Teachers would be requested to share all the study material so that students can cope up with the loss owing to low internet connectivity etc. especially students residing in remote parts of the country.
6. COURSEERA for CAMPUS: College would establish a tie-up with COURSEERA for courses free of cost for students.

Apart from this, a separate web extension was planned for admissions to meet any eventuality with complete digital access to Admissions 2020. Also, the institute decided to keep on updating on the COVID response including guidelines issued by the central government and the university and helpful tips and advice for students and useful links would be provided.

Principal highlighted that continuous review meetings would be required to be organized to ensure the smoothness in the teaching-learning and admission related assignments along with coping with the pandemic.

### ASIAN UNDERGRADUATE SUMMIT

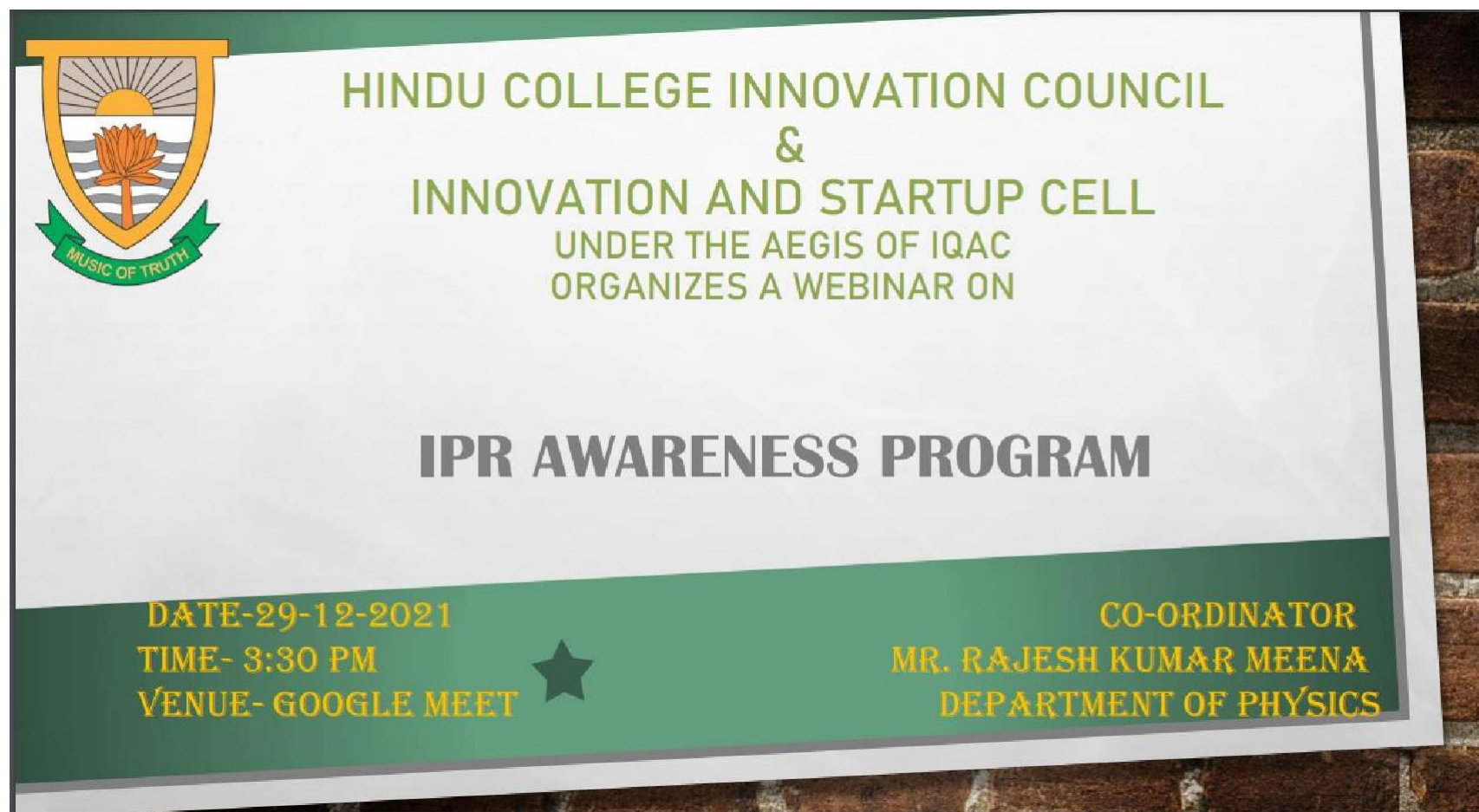
