The year saw several notable achievements for the College culminating in the 120th Founder's Day on 15 February 2019, with Dr. Satya Pal Singh, Hon'ble Minister of State, Human Resource Development & the Ministry of Water Resources, River Development and Ganga Rejuvenation, as the Chief Guest.

The College organized a number of successful events such as *Vaktavya'19* – the two day Annual Conclave of Hindu College, Mushairah'19 – the Hindi edition of the Annual Literary Festival, and Samvaad'19. These events were graced by noted personalities like Justice Dipak Misra, Mr. Manish Sisodia, Ms. Shazia Ilmi, Mr. Vineet Narain, Mr. Prakash Karat, Dr. Charan Singh, Maj. Surendra Poonia, Mr. K.P. Fabian, Mr. Hukmdev Narayan Yadav, Mr. Saurabh Dwivedi, Mr. Asghar Wajahat, Ustad Abdul Hamid Sabri, Padmashree awardee Shri. Surendra Sharma, Gen. P.K. Sehgal, Mr. Arvind Gaur, Ms. Ira Singhal. Mecca – the Annual Cultural Festival of the college was a great success and saw participation from colleges in and outside of Delhi. The three-day fest included a number of formal and non-formal events along with performances by popular artists and bands.
